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# Daily Devotions

## **MONDAY // Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-14, Romans 16:1, 1 Corinthians 6:5-8, Eph. 5:22-27, 1 Peter 5:1-4**

- List the four metaphors scripture uses to describe the church. What is the same between all four?
- What does this imply about church being a building? Why is this important for Christians to understand?
- How does this challenge your previous perspective on church? What difference does this make for you?

## **TUESDAY // Read Matthew 10:40, 25:44-45, John 17:20-23, 26, Acts 9:1-5, Ephesians 1:15-23**

- In what way did Jesus describe His relationships to Christians? How would this also apply to the church?
- What does this highlight about the role of "the church" today? (i.e. hands and feet of Jesus)
- Why is it important for Christians to embrace this truth? How can you do a better job of embracing it?

## **WEDNESDAY // Read 1 Corinthians 12:13-14, Matthew 3:11, John 3:5, 2 Corinthians 5:17, Gal. 3:26-28**

- What two things spiritually happen when someone becomes a Christian? How does this relate to church?
- In what way does this highlight the difference between attending and participating in church?
- How does it make you feel knowing you have a spiritual role at PCC? How does it challenge you?

## **THURSDAY // Read 1 Corinthians 12:4-7, 14-18, Romans 12:3-6a**

- Why does God give Christians spiritual gifts? What can happen if the "purpose" is misunderstood?
- In what way will this negatively impact the effectiveness of a church? How have you seen this happen?
- How have you been blessed by others using spiritual gifts? How does this encourage you to use yours?

## **FRIDAY // Read 1 Corinthians 12:8-10, 28, Romans 12:6-8, Ephesians 4:11**

- What is implied by the three spiritual gifts listed in scripture? (i.e. differences) Why is this important?
- What are the differences and similarities between a natural talent and a spiritual gift?
- How can a talent help identify a spiritual gift? How can Team PCC help you confirm your gift?

## **SATURDAY // Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-18, 1 Timothy 4:14-15**

- How does unity and diversity relate to spiritual gifting within the church? In what way is it a benefit?
- What happens when Christians aren't using their spiritual gifts? Give an example.
- What does it imply about a Christian's personal and spiritual responsibility? How will you step into that at PCC?

**MEDITATION VERSE:** <sup>4</sup>Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; <sup>5</sup>and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; <sup>6</sup>and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. <sup>7</sup>To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. - 1 Corinthians 12:4-7
