Point #1

- Read Exodus 2:1-3. Summarize the various ways that Jochebed personally sacrificed for Moses.
- In what way was this mother's love for her child similar to the type of love God has for you?
- How does Point #1 make you feel about your mom? Be specific. How can you pass this on to others?

Point #2

- Read Exodus 2:4-10. Explain how Jochobed's plan to save Moses was very strategic and not random.
- How is this type of wisdom different than what can be learned from a book or college course?
- Reflect on Point #2 and share some wisdom you learned from your mother? How does this encourage you?

Daily Devotions

These are provided for mid-week personal spiritual growth. Prayerfully writing out your answers will help you experience real life transformation as you dig deeper into the spiritual truths of God's word and today's message.

MONDAY // Read Exodus 2:1-3, Numbers 26:59, John 3:16, 14:6, 1 John 4:19

- How did Jochebed respond when she had a baby boy? What would have been her mixed emotions?
- How did her decision put her personally at risk? How does this model The Gospel and God's love?
- In what way have you experienced a mother's sacrificial love? Be specific. How does this encourage you?

TUESDAY // Read Exodus 2:1-3, 1 Samuel 1

- How did both Jochebed and Hanna personally sacrifice for their children? Be specific.
- How did Pharaoh's daughter highlight this isn't limited to only biological mothers?
- In what way were their personal sacrifices in the best interest of the children? What does this highlight?

WEDNESDAY // Read Exodus 2:4-10, 2 Timothy 1:1-5, Proverbs 31:25-27

- Explain the distinction between a mother's wisdom and the wisdom found in universities today?
- How has the world devalued a mother's role and God's plan for imparting wisdom to children?
- In what way have you experienced this devaluing? Give an example. Take time to pray for mothers today.

THURSDAY // Read Exodus 2:4-10, Luke 1:26-38, 46-56, 2:21-35, 41-48, John 2:1-5, 19:25-27

- Throughout Jesus' life we see a unique and special relationship between mother and son. Explain.
- What does this implicitly teach about God's plan for moms and their kids? How is it different than fathers?
- What is God teaching you about either being a mom or relating to your own mother? Be specific.

FRIDAY // Read Exodus 2:4-10, 20:12, Proverbs 31:28-31

- Explain what God calls you to do when it comes to honoring your mother. Give an example.
- Why is this important and what are the ramifications of this command? How will this challenge culture?
- What specific steps will you take to obey the Lord and honor your mother throughout the year?

SATURDAY // Read Exodus 2:1-10, Genesis 3:20, Proverbs 23:25

- As you reflect on the original God-given role of a mother, what is God teaching you?
- In what way have you seen the significance of motherhood decline in today's world? Why?
- How does this discussion about moms and kids ultimately come down to a relationship with God?
