

Point #1

- Read Philemon 15-16. In what way was Paul expanding Philemon's perspective? Why was this important?
- How does Point #1 highlight this truth? How does this same principle apply to resolving relational conflict today?
- Explain the difference between being respectful and dogmatic. How does Point #1 adjust you?

Point #2

- Read Philemon 17-20. What specifically did Paul ask Philemon to do to remedy the conflict?
- How was this a demonstration of Point #2? In what way did Paul also proactively address any potential pushback?
- In what way can relational conflict get stuck in fault finding? Give an example. How does Point #2 help you?
