### Point #1

- a) Read Philemon 21-22. How was Paul applying a glass half full perspective? What could half empty have been?
- b) What is the impact on both of these for reconciliation. How does Point #1 keep reconciliation on the table?
- c) In what way is this about walking in love? (c.f. 1 Cor. 13:7-8) How does Point #1 adjust your current approach?

### Point #2

- a) Read Philemon 23-25. What is implied about these five men sending a greeting? How does this relate to Point #2?
- b) Why was this important when it comes to working through relational conflict? How can this be overlooked?
- c) In what way have you underestimated Point #2 in your relationships? What insight is God giving you this week?
